ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Black Death Is Complete. The great pestilence sort of just fizzed away. Nations who had been affected his turn, have had all their city builds and expansion, megalithic construction and public works projects canceled due to a lack of manpower. Any GP (Gold Points) put in these were put back into saved. All troop builds, including wall points, and investments were continued as before.

New Army Unit, Artillery: One nation this turn has just invented Artillery. Early on, they are curiosities designed to scare the opponent, but later in the Renaissance Era, they will become a deadly instrument of war, both on land and on sea. It costs Infp & 5gp to build an Artillery point (a). No mation can invest in Artillery QR unless they gain Tech Level 7 -or-a Tech Level 6 nation obtains the secrets of Artillery from a nation with gun knowledge.

University Stats: There are new stats under the University section. These are the same stats described in the 5th Edition. Rulebook section [2.9]. The first figure is University Investment: That is how much GP and or NFP you have put in the University system over the years. The second number is the Years in Operation. This is how long the University has been open. This number is a rough guess based on history, both campaign and real. If you think the number is different let me know of it. The third stat is University Level. The University Level is how effective the University is in education its people. This number is directly added to each turn's tech point formula, so the bigger this number is the more likely you will advance technologically. I am using a different formula than what is printed in the 5th Edition Rulebook. Technology Level does not reflect the size of an University, it only reflects a University's ability to advance a given country. The lower the Technology Level, the higher the University Level might be.

More on Those Color Maps: It's true. All regions that a nation controls are included on the Color Map. Including those obtained by secret diplomacy & other secret actions. I used these color maps as a reference tool when processing orders. All regions must be colored including the regions of a secret land empire (a regular nation so isolated that it can be secret). Please be advised.

LORDS 10 UNIT CONVERSION

Each point of cavalry and infantry (light or heavy) represents 500 fighting men. A transport or warship point = 5 ships with 100 men aboard. A siege point = 5 siege towers or 50 cataputs or 500 sappers. A war elephant point = 50 elephants ridden by mahouts. A field fort point = 5 forts manned by 100 men each. A wall point = 10 feet of wall ramparts. An artillery point = 5 guns arnd assorted men.

In its last five years the Black Death slowed down its pace of destruction. The germs just weren't gestating like they used to. The Plague didn't catch in West Africa despite an overseas trade route. In the Far East, it ground to a halt, stopped by Chinese herbs and medicines. So the wave of pestilence only advanced further in Central Asia. It also spread northward to decimate horde populations. The Vabol, Silnorak, Tuttorks, Tadzhiks, Jastou and Sangurg tribes were especially affected. The process of rebuilding has already begun...

AFRICA

West Africa

Mercs: 10mw, 20mi

THE AKA'MURRID EMIRATE OF FULANI

Mustafa II, Emir of the Fulani

DIPLOMACY: Hausa(c), Kebbi(t), Kurfei(t), Segu(ea), Niani(nt), Galam(hs)

The Emir got back to the Sahel to perform some diplomacy to the Nigerine cities. Seldez after a stopover in Segu took his Gambian wife back to Gao to sire some offshoots. Two boys were born - they were pampered by everyone in the city. There were some stories of the white people dying from sickness. It amused the Gaoti folk to hear of other people's miseries. Hajan's tour of the Malinke West was cut short in Galam. There he was beset by xenophobic savages who threw spears at him. Hajan and his 1000 mounted guardsmen screened an escape path to Niani, his pride wounded. The Bakongo army left the Yoruba garrison alone. Their constant movement irritated Mustafa Emir.

THE KINGDOM OF BORNU

Belgun Malik

DIPLOMACY: Kanem(ea), Daza(fa)

Old Belgun stayed in Kanem, becoming a familiar face to those who dwelled there.

THE SUPREMACY OF TOGO

Bakambo, Supreme Oba of Togo

DIPLOMACY: Asante(t)

Bakambo pulled the fleet from trade with the Almoravids fearing an outbreak of the Plague. Fortunately nobody got sick and the Supremacy was spared from utter devastation.

THE BANTU KINGS OF KONGO

Mambele, King of Ba-Congo

DIPLOMACY: Igbo(nt), Lunda(nt), Cuango(t)

The Kongo knew when they were beat. Mambele's new army played it safe marching up to the Fulani border and crossing it at times to see if it could be done. Eventually they stopped the fun stuff and retired to Port Kachunk after a nice visit in Igbo. Benin became cultivated.

East Africa

Mercs: 10mi, 10mw

THE GREAT ZIMBABWE

Five Twin Jackal, Immortal Ancestor of the Zimbabwe, Chief Zimbabwe Royal DIPLOMACY: none

The Immortal had his new lieutenant Gas Tooth fetch 15,000 new heavies in Melela. They waited for any coughing dirtbags to attack from all directions. There were none coming. Five Twin declared this border clean and drew a sigh of relief.

THE TULAKA RAJOFSAKALAVA

Vishuhapa

DIPLOMACY: Merintha(c)

Crown Prince Hasakaramja took 85 boats and 7000 mostly heavy swordsmen across the Mozambique channel and up to Cape Delgado to do some headbanging. Mombassa, a former Soko tributary, seemed like a good place to expand Tulaka domination. But as the warriors landed on the beach, 10,000 natives appeared on the beach. After a brief engagement Hasakaramja was wounded and all his surviving force (3500) had to flee to the boats. The Mombassa cheered and shouted insults at the Tulaka.

In Sakalava, both Hasakaramja and King Manathuraja died of plague related illness. A regency was elevated to preside in the name of boy-king Vishuhapa.

THE BASOKO

Zharru the Unfortunate

DIPLOMACY: Kimbu(c), Ankolye(nt)

Zharru knew of the Tulaka invasion and was angry. But there was little he could do. His son, Njombe, went to Mombassa but found no port to hire warships. So Njombe had to rely on the contingency plan - convert the people there to animism (they are Muslim), but Njombe's heart wasn't in it. In July 1377, Hindu Tulaka fighters attacked. Njombe's heart leaped. He hired 5000 mercenaries and joined the local Sharif and the Mombassa 5000 to drive back the 1000 archers and 6000 mace pounciders. Near the village of Kisiju, the hated Tulaka were forced to retreat to the sea. The Sharif was so pleased that he offered his lovely daughters to Prince Njombe -but Njombe had to convert to Islam. That was an act was treason according to his father, Zharru. Njombe chose love over country and thus was no longer a Basoko Prince. Zharru made his next son Mitwaba the heir, cursing his eldest son for denying the true religions. The Black Death put an end to technological development. The Soko were overcome with misery and poverty, just like before.

THE ZAG WEKINGDOM OF AETHIOPIA

Ohas, Ras Teniguwa, King of Aethiopia: DIPLOMACY: none

The Zagwe unleashed their saved treasure to offer relief to the plague ravaged nation. Tobruk, Luxor, Amada, Bur Sudan, Massawa, Aseb and Soba were grown to accommodate larger populations. Public works were built in the key economic areas. Merchant shipping rebounded. Trade with Saxonia restarted. Gunar II, having survived the Black Death, died of Small Pox in 1380. Ohas was primed for his ascension to kinghood. His emaciated frame was made glutinous with vest of fur and silk. The Institute of Merce was endowed with generous grants from the new lion. Just north of the border, Italian Pirates have stationed themselves along the Ghebal Gharib bank of the Nile, using an old Ghorid port. They preyed upon the Byzantine trade route plundering every ship that passes. Just south, an Italian army has regional genocided Aswan's Hindus. At least that's good news.

EUROPE

Western Europe

Mercs: 10mhc, 10mc, 10mhi, 10mi

THE REPENTANT SULT A NATE OF IEST

Juroha "Roach Killer", Destroyer of the Unclean Vermin Insects DIPLOMACY: none

The refugees gathered around less were put to work immediately building new cities upon the ruins of old ones. Oran in Cheliff, Tunis in Kabilya, Madiera in Murcia, Marsala in Sicily were restored - all were ports. lest grew to 2 GPv and the region of Africa's farms were restored to former glory. Most of Juroha's treasury remained in the vault for better projects were yet to come. Overseas trade with Thaery were revived. That at least, was a start.

Interesting rumors spread in the lower city: It seems it was the Caliph of Baghdad who had sponsored the Crescent Moon to unleash the Black Death upon the world. Being too far way, Madina rebelled.

THE COUNTY OF CONNAUGHT

Clancy Mac Duc, Count of Connaught DIPLOMACY: Lienster(ea), Munster(a)

Dewey handed off two saucy wenches, his daughters, to many important chieftains in Munster and Lienster. The old man died and deeded his estate to his bedridden son Clarcy.

THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF SAXONIA (Parti Nord)

Henry (III) of Ponthieu, King of the Saxons and of the Normans, Count of Blois DIPLOMACY: Normandy(nt, till they mutinied - had to be pacified), Ponthieu(home)

King Robert III gave up and elected James of Poitou to be his successor. In Robert's mind, James was not worthy of being king. So Robert decided to threw a wrench into the works. A message was sent to Henry of Ponthieu, the new alty, to take command of the main arrany and join up with King in Normandy. Robert then sat back to watch the show.

Henry of Ponthieu couldn't believe his incredible luck. He, a mere ally, was to be trusted to lead and control the rmain Saxon army. That's over 120,000 fighting men. With all the power, the temptation was too great. In February 1377, Henry announced that he would be King of Saxonia effective immediately. Someone slipped passed him and wounded him. But King Robert, Pembroke and Chatham and their puny army of only 10,000 had to run away. With the military right behind him, Henry acted as fast as he could to outmaneuver James of Poitou. He took Ponthieu and the loyalty of Bishop Dual, lie de France, Vermandois, Lorraine, Flanders, Sussex and much of the government, Wessex, Anglia, Mercia, Northumbria, Dyffed, Lothian and Strathcyde. Even with civil war, cities expanded: Ipswich, Bruges, Paris, Cologne, Hull, Rouen the new capital, London and Soissons. Normandy had to be crushed when they thought

civil unrest would allow their liberty. The Saxon government was moved to Ponthieu where the new king, Henry III, could watch it more closely.

THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF SAXONIA (Parti Soud)

James of Poitou, King of the Saxons and of the Normans, Count of Blois DIPLOMACY: Poitou(home)

Old King Robert abdicated soon after he escaped to Brittany. He asked his most loyal general Chatham to join the Ponthieu King. Chatham did so leaving Pembroke in Brittany. Both Robert and Chatham died in 1380.

James of Poitou was too busy to notice all this. If Robert won't be king, then he would be. The unappreciated son-in-law gained control of Anjou, Aquitaine, Aragon, Armagnac, Asturias, Brittany, Castille, Catalonia, Cornwall, Gascony, Languedoc, Lyonnais, and Poitou. James' country estate became a capital of a fair chunk of the Norman Realm. Tour, Toulouse, Valladolid, Barcelona, Helston, Sete and Vienne grew 1 GPv each too. Trade was divided. Between the two factions, the Poitou was fortunate to have control of the wealthy Mediterranean commerce. This may be James' only blessing in a nightmare scenario.

THE ALMORAVID EMIRATE OF ANDALUSIA

Marwan II, Emir as Sevilla DIPLOMACY: none

Much of the Almoravid public works were rebuilt after the destruction brought to the country by the Plague. Cities expanded as well: Kazmedina, Sevilla, Dokhla, El Aaiun, Agadir, Cordoba, Al Kiffa, Casablanca, Porto and Sagunto all got increased 1 GPv each. Marwan kept track of the Emirate's doing and made a few rulings when a dispute could not be decided by low ranking jurists.

Italy

Mercs: 10mhi, 10mi, 5mw

THE LIGURIAN KINGDOM OF ITALY

Marcus, Rex Lagobardum DIPLOMACY: none

The Ligurians were not immune from the city expansion thing. Venezia, Livorno, Pescara, Marseilles, Genoa, Napoli, Reggio and Tarantum got improved 1 GPv each. Public works got build everywhere too. Gulio Dulio and L'Bamertul loaded 6000 knights aboard 260 galleys and merchant lanteens and called off to Egypt, beyond the reach of communication. News of their adventure reached Genoa by hearsay. It seems that Gulio Dulio and Barnertul had a falling out. Since Gulio controlled the ships, Barnertul and the cavalry were thrown out along the banks of the Nile. L'Bamertul did make it to Aswan and succeeded in genocided the Hindu carnel riders there. Gulio Dulio has become a buccaneer and is feared by sailors all over the Mediterranean. While poking around in Calabria, Prince Balscar found a really nifty pearl that glowed in the dark. He showed his friends that and they were amazed. In 1378, Balscar became very ill but by grasping the pearl, he found he could get better. The following year, Pope Honorius III paid a visit to the royal palace in Genoa. He crowned Marcus as "King of Italy" by placing the Iron Crown of the Lombards on Marcus' head. Grain surpluses were passed on to the Poitou Saxon Faction, Styria and the Papacy. A gift of 200 GP was delivered to Styria to help the hairy rascal out.

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

Leo XII, Bishop of Rome, Vicar of Christ, Servant of the Servants of God, Supreme Pontiff on the Universal Church DIPLOMACY: none

"It is the solemn duty of the Holy See to aid the Catholic Princes in maintaining the Christian Commonwealth."

-Honorius III, Spring 1377

The Pontiff swung into action building abbeys everywhere his priests could bless. Lithuania, Nordgau, Franconia, Corsica, Calabria, Reggio, Tarantum, Slovenia, Carinthia, Bakony, Austria, Bavarria, Provence, Lyonnais, Vienne, Orleans, Anjou, Tours and He de France each got one. Cathedrals were built in important central towns in Normandy and Swabia. Rome itself expanded to 7 GPv, one of the largest cities in Europe. University assistance was delivered to the Polish Kingdom. Financial aid was sent to Styria. Honorius III ended his illustrious reign by crowning Marcus of Liguria, King of Italy. Pope died in 1380. A new one got elected in short order. The suffering of the Black Death diminished greatly thanks to the efforts of the Church.

Eastern Europe

Mercs: 30mc, 10mi

THE REPUBLICOF STYRIA

Othello di Haas, Grand Doge of Trangau DIPLOMACY: Nordgau(f), Burgundy(a)

The efforts of Styria to rebuild its broken economy was assisted by Liguria and the Church. Some 500,000 khaosorben were accumulated in Othello's treasury. These were spent on public works in Bavaria, Champagne, Illyria, Nordgau, Slovenia and Tyrol. In exchange for 70,000 khaosorben, the Byzantines granted the Republic full control over Croatia. Othello's son Titus was elevated to be a prince and was groomed by the courtiers to succeed the Ebon Doge. Lelander of Burgundy and Citherione of Illyria both grew to 2 GPv. Frankfurt, a new city was built around the inlaund tower in Franconia. The port of Neuhamelin was founded along the Rhine in Hesse. Lord Dytermann became the admiral of the navy. He took 2000 longbow men and boarded them aboard

65 elite warships. There wasn't enoug#n room for the Italian refugees on board the small hold ships. It wouldn't have mattered anyway. Dytermann's landing force was outmaneuvered by 4000 Corsicans. The admiral was killed and the navy sailed to Burgundy with 500 survivors.

THE NORDIK KINGDOM OF THAERY

Jaksur, King of the Danes DIPLOMACY: none

Jaksur ruled until 1377 when he was overthrown by Romer Asha Knori, his best general. Romer became Romer III the first king of the Khorig Dynasty. Relief was given to the farmers. Liege, Vigo, Norkoping, The Hague, Avente, Malmo, Stockholm and København gerew in city size. Pereaslavi became cultivated. Loud, thundering sounds were heard in København at the docks. People mobbed around royal Danish militia exploding stone balls out of a hard clay tube. Each time they shot the stones, the tube would crack some more. Romer was pleased of this new invertion. It was called by the Kollegium professors a "Gunnhildr" or "Gun" for short.

THEGRANDPRINCIPALITY OF WARSAW

Casimir, Grand Prince of Warsaw

DIPLOMACY: none

The Poles demobilized their beached transports, retraining their crew as cavalry. A city was rebuilt in Obodria, Gdansk. Its port is next to the River Elbe. Trade with the Ponthieu Saxons was allowed from there. Public Works were built in all cultivated areas. Pomerania was colonized to (0/3) Roman Catholic.

THE KINGDOM OF THE BALTS

Rurik II. King of Baltica. Prince of Novgo Fod

DIPLOMACY: Veposkava(ea)

With a labor shortage after the Black Death, it made no sense to maintain a slave based economy. This was converted to a guild system. All slaves were assigned to different occupations. Rurik's 34,000 Russian axe-men attacked and pacified Starodiub. Rurik satisfied that threy won't upraise went back to Novgorod to learn crochet. The Veposkavans like Igor's tall, colorful hats.

THE BALTIC PRINCIPATE ON THE VOLGA

Nikolai Yaskusk, Prince of Kubishev

DIPLOMACY: Veposkava(ea)

The Volga Balts rejoiced. They were be spared from the Black Death.

THE DIHZ HOST

Tagaktu, Mighty Servant of Allah

DIPLOMACY: Don(home)

Tagaktu settled his tribes in Don, making the land his homeland. uninhabited Nogai, the last tribe was settled. Nogai is now a (1/5) Sunni friendly region. Then the Black Death struck by trade route from the west. Sarkel and Atil were destroyed. With decimated garrisons, Rezh and Yayik rebelled.

Tagaktu still had most his host troops but the feared enemies in the Eastern Steppe were rurnored to be stronger. It was said that the hostile pagan tribe, the Blublog, are about to attack. Taman became neutral rather than join the Dihaj. Tagaktu noticed Warsaw spies in his armies. They were caught, tried and executed in many bizarre ways.

ASIA

The Middle East

Mercs: 10mhc, 10mc, 10mhi, 10mi, 5ms

THE NIKEPHORIAN EMPIRE OF BYZANTION

Nicephorus XII, Eastern Roman Emperor, Basileus of Constantinople DIPLOMACY: no effect

There was much construction in the Eastern Roman world as well. Varna, Ephesus, Chalcedon (which faces the West Black Sea in Optimaton), and Katerini grew to 4 GPv. Salonika becarne 7 GPv. In Paphlagonia the port of Sinope was transformed into a 1 GPV town. An Imperial Road was built connecting Belgrad of Bosnia to Ludgiorie over mountains. From Ephesus, another road went over Lydia and Phrygia to connect Hieropolis. The Church of St. Sophia in the Constantinople citadel was expanded to include several city blocks. The surrounding grounds were called the Hanging Gardens of St. Sophia'. The Constantine Academy was moved to Nicepolis to make room for the sprawling sanctuary. Post-plague re-lief was granted to the suffering country towns and villages in exchange for a nominal fee, Croatia was given to the German Republic. Ozu and Atelikuzo were released. Shuttle fleets connected Klev and Cherson and all the islands to improve government efficiency. In exchange for being peaceful, the Saraciens surrendered control of Galatia and Psidia. There was much resistance by the inhabitants as Steophanos, Basil and Yarios tried to move the Muslims out by force. The survivors were driven to Cilicia. The deed was completed with only a few legionnaire deaths. Galatia was resettled by Orthodox Christians to (2/5). Psidia to (0/6). Nikephorus XI died of constipation. He was only 44. His child son, Nikephorus #12 became the new Emperor at age 7. Hellin Poskos, an uncle, took on the chore of regency. Greek merchants wonder why their merchant fleets have been turned away from Levantine Muslim ports. Piracy has harmed the trade route to Abyssinia.

THE PIRATASOF GULIO DULIO

Gulio Dulio. Pirate. Esquire

DIPLOMACY: none

The Pirates virtually shut down the route between Abyssinia and the Byzantines. With the new crisis arising between the Byzantines and Islam, Gulio Dulio has offered the services of his fleet to the highest bidder (So long as the piratas remain 'Open for a Player"). 50 GP minimum bid. Hand delivery only.

THE DAR AL ISLAM - ARBILIQ CALIPHATE

Al Ma'mum, Kalifat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful DIPLOMACY: Charsionon(nt)

The frontier regions objected when the Caliph surrendered Psidia and Galatia to the infidels. How could he do this? Islam is supposed to advance forward - not go backwards. As refugees from the "Lost Territories" starting filing into Cilicia, hearts were inflamed for vengeance which swept the entire Arab World.

Al Ma'mum paid more attention to increasing the domestic output of his people. Basra, Antioch, Adana, Acre grew larger with more population. Public works were improved or repaired in Fars, Abadan, Hahmar, Hormuz, Iraq, Jazirah, Jibal, Karbala, Khuzestan, Kuwait and Mand. The Mesopotamian regions of Abadan, Hahmar, Iraq and Jazirah returned to intense cultivation.

The repercussions of the "Lost Territories" came back to haunt Al Ma'mum. If he made any agreement with Emperor Nicephorus, it is gone now. Ulama clerics and mullah called for a jihad to topple the Byzantine Empire and avenge their umma brothers who were driven from Asia Minor. They called on the Caliph himself to lead the holy charge against the forces of corruption for the glory of Allah and his prophet Mohammad. Thousands of Jihadine appeared at Adana, Baghdad and all over the Dar al Islam to beat up Greek Orthodox Christians.

Taman rebelled when it was no longer wanted.

THE PARTHID SHAHDOM OF RAYY

Yuhana bin Isma'il, Shah of Rayy

DIPLOMACY: Gurgan(nt), Dasht Kavir(t)

Yuhana converted his saved manpower in a mighty cavalry force. Then with what was left, he hired all the mercenaries in the area. The Bajjids will pay for exiling Yuhana to Rayy. In Gurgan, the 22,500 mercenaries and 48,500 cavalry encountered 31,500 Bajjid soldiers attempting to racketeer some tribute. Led by the war-prince Haskath, they put up a good fight. But Yuhana had them outnumbered and all were stain by the Rayy army. As Yuhana marched to Merv in triumph, his army got sick of Plague. Only 23,500 were well enough to continue. While in Jowzjanan, the Parthids were joined by 8500 Karatou whose aims were similar to Yuhana's own. As the Parthids pacified Jowzjanan, the Karatou sacked and burned Merv. Yuhana recovered the treasury and a portion of the Bajjid library before Merv went up in smoke.

Yuhana continued on to Khurasan, forcing tribute from the land and then got Dasht Kavir to accept his hegemony. As the Shah was conquering, the Black Death did a number on the Shahdom. Ravy and Timova were reduced to 1 GPv cities. Babal Sar and Isfahan became lifeless husks. Tabaristan became a wilderness territory.

THE BAJJID EMIRAT OF MERV

Haskath, Emir of Merv, Archon of Bactria

DIPLOMACY: none

Haskath had planned on recovering lost territory and then sticking it to the Karatou. He didn't expect the Parthids to intervene at all. His force of 19,000 cavalry, 5000 knights, 4000 swordsmen and 3500 sappers, carefully assembled, were completely destroyed in Gurgan - of all places. Haskath ran back to Merv just ahead of the Rayy army to find that Karatou troops had infiltrated into his homeland. There was nothing he could do to stop them. He abandoned his keep, seeking refuge in Tukharistan. Merv was destroyed by the invaders. Jowzjanan and Khurasan were conquered away. With a skeleton government left, Kuhistan rebelled. Haskath needs to liberate Jowzjanan so he can recruit reinforcements - but he had no army. He should have never torn down those city

THE KHANATE OF KARATOU

Ishfat, Khan of Karatou DIPLOMACY: Soghdia(fa)

Ishfat had his say in the Bajjid matter. He snuck right up to Merv, sacked and burned the city and took home the loot. He had to go home. His nation was overcome with a killer epidemic, the same one that crippled the world. Samarkhand was erased. Khiva and Tashkent reduced to 2 GPv towns. The Karatou society became more liberal, more open and free than other nations in Central Asia.

THE GHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTAN

Ibrahim, Sultan of Afghans DIPLOMACY: none

The capital of the Sultanat, Ghanzi, was rebuilt in Zabulistan. Chah Bahar and Antizani grew to 3 GPv each. Baluchistan became cultivated. Ibrahim is five years older than he used to be.

India

Mercs: 10mwe, 10mhc, 10mc, 10mi, 5ms

THE HARAYUK RAJPUT EMPIRE

Nagantha, Khan of Khans, Master of Kaunaj DIPLOMACY: Sukkur(ea, with an offer of a city)

The Maharaja of the Rajputs, Nagantha headed to Sukkur to show off his horde slaying army. The Sukkur were duity impressed when an offer of a city was presented. Charukapa caught the Plague there and died. Grown to 4 GPv: Patna, Kaunaj and Delhi. To 2 gold levels: Benares and Multan.

THE SANTAN U DYNASTY OF GOBLIGUK

Santan Sholalit

DIPLOMACY: none

The Santanu lost its Aswan outpost when everyone there were killed by an Italian expeditionary army. Sholalit was happy that nobody attacked his little kingdom.

THE CHALUKYA KINGDOM OF BAN AVASI

Chalukya Saivahesa

DIPLOMACY: Pawar(c), Kakatiya(c)

The Muta wandered around the Tapti-Purua valleys to find a way to connect isolated Chela to the rest of the Kingdom. The Plan didn't work. Chela was still isolated. Vishurvardhana got tired and sick. He died in 1380. A regency had to be assembled to rule far too young, Saivahesa.

THE SHAGUNGA EMPIRE

Derajtra Shagunga, Emperor of Konorak

DIPLOMACY: Kosala(t)

A port fortness, up the coast by the North-east, from Konorak was erected. Derajtra gathered up his surviving armies and defended his capital city with them.

South-East Asia

Mercs: 5mwe, 5mc, 10mhi, 20mi, 10mw

THE KINGDOMOF PAGAN

Awg Sau, King of Pagan, Maharaja Myarımar

DIPLOMACY: Kedah(ea)

Awg Sau tried but found he couldin't get any boys born for his nighttime efforts. Pagan will probably have to be ruled by a woman unless a worthy prince was found. The old war hero Aswa died in Assam. Lhasa and Mangfu got up to 3 GPv. The Golden Portals grew to 2 GPv as did the capital, Pagan.

THE AQUARIUM OF JAVA

Troutimeutra II, King of the Spice Islands

DIPLOMACY: none

The Java rnerchant ships reestablished trade with many possible trade partners. Chekiang and Chalukyas were too far away. Vietnam refused trade. The Aquarium used their funds to expand all eight of their cities. Atjeh turned to cultivation and is less Oceanic Pagan.

China

Mercs: 5mehc, 5mec, 10mehi, 10mei, 10mew

THE DAI VIET GUO

Van Nguyen, Wang Dai Viet

DIPLOMACY: none

The Annamese were not going to up—ended by those wet people that should never be dealt with. All existing cities except Leizhou became 4 GPv. Two new towns became cities: In Chiennan, Guai; along the serene banks of the Dongting Hu, Kwangte's port Gongli. Everyone at the capital chipped in to help control the vast territory of Vietnam in the aftermath of the Black Death.

THE HIDDEN DRAGON OF CHEKIANG

Quan Zinco, Celestial Emperor of Chekiang

DIPLOMACY: none

Admiral Fuchoi and Lin Kaen sailed back to Japan with mercenaries and fresh troops to finish off the indigenous licingdom there. Things looked promising because Hidden Dragon spies had just kidnapped their 'Emperor' Shimei. The Japanese must now be disarray.

Try telling that to Quai Chang. He was the marshal whose 16,500 elite heavy cavalry and 19,500 elite cavalry were ordered to hold on to Shimane until reinforcements could arrive. He had to face off a horde of fighting monks inflamed with fury. There were over 100,000 of them, willing to die for their stupid Emperor's honor. Quai Chung retreated with only 5500 cavalry leaving the 30 foot walls to be torn down from inside and outside by angry Japanese fighters.

Quai Chang's misfortunes continued. The mob followed him to Yamaguchi, destroying what was left of his army (his: 5500 cavalry and the garrison of 5000). Quai Chang had no choice. Fuchoi and Lin Kaen's fleet of 1575 boats unloaded their 15,000 mercenaries and 5500 garrison relief at the unfriendly port of Yonago. When Fuchoi noticed the lack of welcome it was too late, the Japanese holy warriors were on them and routed the landing army right at the port. Fuchoi searched the coastline capturing 100 transports and went home ashamed of this reversal.

At Linan's harbor Yaozhuan inspected the junk that secretly stole the Emperor of Japan home. He found that Tenno Shimei had killed himself by impaling his stomach with a wooden stave. Rats had already half eaten his corpse. Yaozhuan died himself in bed in 1380. The same physicians who kept the Black Death from affecting China could not save their master. The new Chinese Emperor is the 16 year old Zinco. Admiral Fuchoi and Lin Kaen has also passed away from the same mysterious illness.

DIPLOMACY: Yen(f), Bao Ding(a), Shangtung(f)

Geizer finally kicked the bucket, plowing the south forty. Hiacian was happy that certain sick rats did not park themselves in his North Kingdom.

THE NIHON EMPIRE

Tenno Komyo, 85th Emperor of Nihon, Descendent of Amaterasu DIPLOMACY: Kingdom of Kumamoto=Saga(nt)

Shimei got some elite cavalry trained when he was kidnapped. Some Chinese scum had broke through the Imperial City's gate and broke into the Holy Tenno's bedroom. When the ninja guards arrived, it was too late. Panic spread in the Holy City - The Tenno is missing! The Chinese had stolen him. He had been murdered. The knot of terrible loss turned swiftly to anger - all over Japan. The anger rose and ordinary people came out to kill the gaigin murderers. In Yamato, General Hatakemutsi found himself commanding 18,000 vendetta samurai, 61,000 'sohei' warrior-monks in addition to his 24,000 elite samurai horsemen. Heartened (but still mad), Hatakemutsi attacked Chekiang's conquered lands. Shimane was overrun, the defender's efforts to break the morale of the sohei bo-stick monks failed to deter their resolve. Sutra Blackwizard

DIPLOMACY: Aanx(home), Camoweal(nt), Arakun(c), Eha-Rana(nt), Dajarra(c), Tir-ar-Dha(nt)

From Aanx, an Akettu region in North Australia, the Blackwizard spoke, "Don't mess with me." He loved those bones. He sat on a chair of human bones. Skulfs lined his royal house. His scepter was a wooden pole with a dried human hand. He told the Arakun to join him. Being Dreamtimers they feared him but also didn't mind. Vishu Darkheart made a longer walkabout showing off his wicked dark sword.

THE AKETTA IMPERIUM

Chetimaja, Sorceress-Queen of the Aketta

DIPLOMACY: none

The Aketta sorcerers eyed leerily of their \mbox{new} co-religionists. Trade started with them anyway.

THE NEW WORLD

The Grand Massif

Mercs: 10mi

MERCAIN

Valentine, Elder King of the Land

DIPLOMACY: Eastern Cree(nt), Mohawk(f), Cayuga(ea)

Duncan and Manhattan grew to 3 GPv. New land was brought into the Bonny Kingdom. The expansion of Manhattan helped to bring Mohawk to friendly status.

Cavalry Count: 64 years.

THE CHOWAN SUPREMACU

Chergua, Chief of Chowan

DIPLOMACY: Monacan(c), Delaware(a), Okawaha(a)

Macqua walked over to see Monacan had any feathers. They had two and traded them for a giant red stone. The Catawba braves couldn't swim, so the Catawba ally stayed at home. Maoqua died of malaria in 1380. Caddo's cultivated.

THE HOPEWELL CONFEDER ACU

Snow Fox

DIPLOMACY: Shawnee(t), Cherokee(c)

Wapi and Adena expanded. The Appalachian foothills were noticed and were talked into joining the Confederacy. Horses were shipped to Oaxaca.

Big Moose

DIPLOMACY: Ottawa(f), Kickapoo(t), Yanktonai(a)

Kickapoo, dejected by their exclusion from the Lakes Wyoming were happy to be visited by Neysaum of the Ottawa. Big Moose's love was in Yanktonai.

The lnka baked cakes out of sweet potatoes but they turned sour that no one would eat them. Then the rains started and prevented a famine from happening.

THE COAPU CHE

Finced, King of the Mapu

DIPLOMACY: none

Cefalo returned to Mapuche, taking his armies out of the Lipe desert (hot) and the Coquimbo wastes (uncomfortable) and depositing them under the shady palms of Pichunche and Mapuche. A port area was built along Mapuche's coast to increase fishing action. Cefalo's death was too early (only 33) and that caused an uproar. The outlying regions of Diaguita and Lipe rebelled.
