## **A** ANNOUNCEMENTS

### **Price Increase:**

Due to increasing workload, the sign-up/per turn cost is now \$7.00. I apologize for any inconvenience this decision may cause.

**More HBZ Stuff:** in an attempt to make determining where you can build mobile units more easier, friendly cities that are within your HBZ are marked on the map with a dot in white (or red). Your respective capitals will also be marked on the map with a diamond symbol (in white or red). (Couldn't find a single star in Windings, go figure...). Please remember that mobile units may only be built in friendly cities.

### **Missionaries**

From this point, any player who sends missionaries to an uncontrolled area that is of a **hostile** organized religion will get no conversion result and a bunch of dead missionaries.

**Leaders & Espionage Actions (Battle Assistance):** In order for a leader to perform this action he must remain with the army he is aiding. APs spent in moving around with the army do not count towards the action itself. The maximum bonus a leader may make using this action is +1. So make sure you've got leaders with high CHA scores on this.

**More on Leaders & Espionage Actions:** I am beginning to get the feeling that this rule is being abused and I may excise it entirely in the near future.

**The Cause Mutiny Operation (CM):** players attempting this operation must produce a valid reason as to why the mutiny would occur or it will automatically fail. And no, "Because I think it should succeed." is not a valid reason.

**The HC Operation:** from this point forward, all HC operations must be done in the Capital (if the nation has one) or the Homeland region. If the monarch is female and the HC die roll is successful, she may do nothing but HC for a full year (measured in AP) and undergoes a leader mortality check at the conclusion of that period. If the HC check is unsuccessful, she may do any other activity that you've put in her orders.

**Interactions between the Hemispheres:** at this point only the Seafaring cultures may sail between the Hemispheres. Once people hit Renaissance, then they may attempt to do so as well. So the New World players should stop trying to get to Europe and Non Seafaring Old World players should do likewise.

**Building units:** The vast majority of units must be built in a city within your HBZ. The exceptions are as follows:

- 1) Ships may be built in a port outside the HBZ if it is the only one available.
- 2) Field forts may be built in any region at NT status or higher.
- 3) Inexperienced infantry may be built in a F region within your HBZ.
- 4) Nomad/Barbarian cultures may build units at a Trade Center within their HBZ.

In all these instances please be aware of the yard capacity for all ships and all heavy class units.

### **Some advice that will (hopefully) speed up processing time):**

- 1) When players are increasing a city, please indicate what the new size will be.
- 2) For ships to be built for conversion to MSP, you can also put what route they're going into in the Builds section. Projects may also be put in the Builds section.
- 3) When building a road link, indicate which region it starts in and which region it's going to. Don't give me city names.
- 4) For players who are not using a standard WORD or XTEL format, please put the information in the following order: Revenue; Maintenance, Investments, Builds, Transfers, Projects, Trade Routes, Intel Ops, Religious Ops, Leader Actions. When indicating an expense, please list gps first then nfp.

## JAPAN & THE PACIFIC RIM

### THE EMPIRE OF NIPPON

*Taira Jiro, Daimyo of Kwanto, Shogun of Japan.*

**DIPLOMACY** Tottori, in Shimane (+7 YfC)

Haro died in late 1242 and was succeeded by his son, Jiro. This event didn't discombobulate things too much. More material was shipped to the mainland in order to put Sikhote under cultivation. Elsewhere, more cities were expanded:

### THE MOLUCCAS SEAHOLD

*Rokaku VI, Lord of the Spice Islands*

**DIPLOMACY** None

Timur was colonized to a (-/8). Attempts to add a level to Brunei failed due to insufficient costs.

### THE MAREE KINGDOM OF AUSTRALIA

*Doongara, Prince of Maree*

**DIPLOMACY** None

Jarrah's son, Doongara came of age in 1242 and the regent stepped down. The new king tried to move some merchant shipping but the player forgot to give the King an IMA order so none was moved. Five more port areas were built however, in Cooma, Goolbura, Maree, Bouganville and Tanimbar. Finally, Birru grew to size 4.

## CHINA

### THE KINGDOM OF SHAN'SI

*Xoing Sung, King of Shan'si, Watcher of the Northern Marches*

**DIPLOMACY** Kin (f)

The Shan'si were busy (as was their wont): missionary and diplomatic activity among the steppe nomads to the north continued and a new road was built between Lu'an and Hsuing Nu, the latter part of which ended at a new city, Uniket. Then there were the usual city expansions:

Finally, Feng Xoing died at the end of 1245 and was succeeded without incident.

### THE KINGDOM OF HUPEI

*Cao Hui Rong, King of Hupei*

**DIPLOMACY** No effect

A royal road was built between Suzhou and Yumen and two observatories were built in the mountainous areas of Fujian and Hopei. The Imperial palaces in the capital were also expanded and a new library was built as well (someone's been playing a lot of CIV IV, I see). Hupei diplomacy continues to be singularly ineffective (leaders dropping dead in the midst of negotiations tend to make it more difficult).

### THE KINGDOM OF KWANGSI

*Wu Juan II, Prince of Kwangsi*

**DIPLOMACY** None

A quiet turn of city expansions was in order:

## SOUTHEAST ASIA & INDIA

### THE KINGDOM OF CHAMPA

*Lon Nol, Regnet for...*

*Khavirhan III, King of Champa, Lord of Vijaya*

**DIPLOMACY** Khemer (+9YfC)

Khavirhan II died in 1241, an event made more complicated by the fact that the Champan player turned in the same set of orders as last turn, which resulted in a lot of stuff not getting done (as it had been done already) and the ref playing accountant. Bad player! No biscuit!

Of the stuff that did get done, missionary activity in Palembang and Sirivjaya continued, as did diplomatic attempts to get the Khemer to play nice.

### THE KINGDOM OF MAGHADA

*Pramsu, Raja of Bengal*

**DIPLOMACY** Uttar Pradesh (a), Tarain (a), Chitor (t)

A new road was built between Rajput and Uttar Pradesh; money and agro were sent to the hungry Moluccans, and a whole bunch of cities were expanded:

### THE KINGDOM OF CHOLA

*Jagrav, King of Chola, Lord of Tanjore*

**DIPLOMACY** Gujerat (c), Pawar (f), Somantha, in Surashtra (f), Kalanjara, in Vatsa (ea)

Not so many cities were expanded this time out:

City (Region)	New Size
Tanjore (Chola)	10
Kakinda (Madurai)	9
Kayal (Anhivarta)	7

In addition to this, a road link between Anhivarta and Pawar was built and work on another between Anhivarta and Surasthra was started. Finally, King Devaj died in late 1245 and was succeeded by his son, Jagrav without incident.

## CENTRAL ASIA

### THE KINGDOM OF JUNGARIA

*Tab-Tangri, Lord of Karakocho.*

**DIPLOMACY** Tabargatai (f)

Aside from some diplomacy, not much was going on here. Tab-Tangri selected one of his grandsons to be heir after the death of the heir apparent, Qing Tan, in 1254.

### THE EMIRATE OF SAMARKHAND

*Al Abdi ibn Selim, Emir of Samarkhand*

**DIPLOMACY** Khazakh (diplomat killed)

Well, first off, there were the usual city expansions:

In addition, new road links were built between Kara-Khitai and both Ferghana and Bokhara. Links were also built from the latter region into both Khwarzim and Singanakh. Finally, the link between Kophat Dagh and Firoz Kohi was finished as well.

In foreign affairs, Al Abdi decided to engage in a spot of expansionism, sending over 20,000 troops into Und and smashing the locals flat. The city of Peshawar was then starved into submission. These actions succeeded despite the fact that many of the troops raised for it were built in several cities in the empire BECAUSE THE PLAYER DIDN'T PAY ATTENTION TO THE YARD CAPACITY LIMITS! SHEESH! Some of them are still sitting in the places they were conscripted in. Finally, an attempt to raid Dasht'e Lute was a failure.

In more peaceable activity, Al Abdi sent a large quantity of both gold and agro to the Khazar Khanate.

### THE KHAZAR KHANATE

*Atakhar, Kagan of Khazar and Saksiny*

**DIPLOMACY** Urkel (a)

A road was built between Alan and the Byzantine lands in Abasigia. Both Empires contributed 1/2 of the funds and manpower to the project.

## THE NEAR EAST

### THE HAMADID SULTANATE

*Faruq al-Motresh, Sultan of Damascus and Protector of the Holy Places*

**DIPLOMACY** Cappadocia (nt)

Screaming with hysterical paranoia, and shaking his little scrubber (that's an old Bloom County line, never mind). Faruq raised more troops and shuffled them about. An attempt to pay the Byzantines back in like coin for last turn's Intel service attack failed.

### THE BUWAYID EMIRATES.

*Azzam ibn Hassim, Emir of Emirs, Protector of the Caliph.*

**DIPLOMACY** None

Things here were fairly quiet. Troops were shuffled about, and grain was sold to the Greeks. Since there didn't seem to be much fighting going on with the infidels, the Ulema didn't grumble too much.

### THE EMIRATE OF ADEN

*Isbaq ibn Mansoor, Emir of Aden and S'ana.*

**DIPLOMACY** None

Additional troops were sent north to assist the Syrians in defending against the infidel scum.

## EASTERN EUROPE

### THE EASTERN ROMAN EMPIRE

*Ion Constantine, Emperor of the Eastern Roman Empire.*

**DIPLOMACY** Vaspurakan (f)

Ion came of age in 1245 and the regent stepped down without incident. In other events, Vaspurakan was put under cultivation and half a road was built between Abasigia and Alan (to better facilitate trade between Constantinople and Khazaria). Missionaries continue to go far and wide, cajoling and debating (especially with their Muslim counterparts in Armenia).

### THE PRINCIPALITY OF MUSCOVY

*Igor, Boyar of Muscovy*

**DIPLOMACY** Pechneg (a)

An attempt to swap Courland and Lithuania to the Poles in exchange for Goryn produced mixed results: Courland was transferred as a (t) region (a status which deteriorated further due to inept Polish diplomacy); Lithuania only transferred as a (c) status, and the Goryites (along with the city of Rivne) repudiated everybody. On the positive side of the ledger, Pechneg, Polotsk, Smolensk and Kur were all put under cultivation and missionary progress in Turov continued. Finally, Ivan died at the end of 1243 and was succeeded by his son, Igor.

### THE KINGDOM OF POLAND

*Boriso, King of Poland*

**DIPLOMACY** Courland (nt)

The usual gaggle of city expansions continued to rock the Polish state (Lorin: please indicate the new city sizes in your orders, thanks):

### THE DUCHY OF ESTONIA

**DIPLOMACY** None

Gotland was sold to the Norse and a treaty was also signed with them. Vaasa was put under cultivation and a new port, Valga, was built there as well. A road was also built between Kalinin and Yaroslav. Konstantine died in 1244 and was followed by his (already elderly) son Enel, the following year. Rule then passed to Enel's son, Jaak.

## WESTERN EUROPE

### THE DUCHY OF BOHEMIA

*Vike Gorner, Duke of Bohemia*

**DIPLOMACY** None

Saarbrucken increased to size 8 and Trier to size 9. Other builds made by the Bohemians were botched. No money or manpower was allocated to either the 102 ht units slotted for Amsterdam this turn (Which is way over the city's yard capacity of 50 in any event. The city could produce a maximum of 50/3 = 16.6 round up to 17 ht units). Heavy Infantry built in Brunswick also exceeded the city's Yard Capacity (heavy land unit count one each) so the remainder were built in Gotha (where they remain). Finally a Great Wall link between Pomern and Lausatia was not built due to non-allocation of gold and nfp.

Finally, Vike died in late 1243, probably due to a burst blood vessel from screaming at his accountants.

### THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

*Innocent III, Bishop of Rome, Vicar of Christ*

**DIPLOMACY** See below...

Church holding continued to spread and expand in various parts of Catholic Christendom. New ground was made in Scandinavia in particular:

More troops were shipped to Tripolitania while both Valetta and Gebel-al-Tarik were converted to the True Faith. Taranto grew to size 8 while Ravenna grew to size 6.

### LE ROYAUME DE FRANCE

*Dareau, King of the Franks*

**DIPLOMACY** None

Not much to report aside from the usual city expansions.

**DIPLOMACY** None

Built troops, shuffled same and purged the Francophile students and faculty from the University of Arles discovered last turn.

## NORTHERN EUROPE

### THE KINGDOM OF WESSEX

*Cearl, Aldwulfson, King of the Angles and Saxons*

**DIPLOMACY:** None

Once again, Cearl found himself paying cab driver, shipping the manpower and money over to Ireland to both cultivate Munster and build a new post road between Lienster and Connaught. Then he returned home to sire some squalling children. Grain was shipped to the Norse and the Pope, the latter via the Papal offices in London.

### THE KINGDOM OF THE SVEAR

*Erik IV, King of the Swedes*

**DIPLOMACY** None

Vadvet Jakko and Karelia were both put under cultivation and the latter region colonized to a (1/6). **Note:** you can't colonize a region to its full gpy the same turn it's cultivated. Erik III died in late 1244 and was succeeded by his son, Erik who was more than happy to take over from the old geezer whom he'd always secretly despised.

### THE NORSE KINGDOM OF ICELAND

*Erik Ottarson, King of the Norse, Dragon King of the Isles*

**DIPLOMACY** None

Ottar decided to help his co-religionists in their never-ending war against the infidel by dispatching his heir Erik with 250 ships and 18,000 troops to the barren wastes of North Africa to sit in the sand with the Italians and Spanish. Closer to home, Stonehaven grew to a size 6 and Stormport to a size 2. The island of Gotland, in the Baltic was occupied from the Estonians in exchange for some gold and a treaty of mutual defense.

And then things went to hell in a hand basket when Ottar died in 1244 and Erik's uncle Gregor tried to seize the throne in an attempted coup. Fortunately, the traitor failed to gain the support of what troops were remaining at home and was quickly strung up. A fast boat was sent all the way to Tripolitania to let the new king know that he was in charge, the Kingdom was practically defenseless and would he please return home with the army before someone decided to conquer the place.

## NORTH AFRICA

---

### THE MAGHREB EMIRATE

*Mohammad ibn Bulent, Emir of Morocco*

**DIPLOMACY** None

Three additional port fortresses were raised, in Merrakesh, Kabilya and Tunisia (gotta keep an eye on those Christians in Tripolitania!). In addition, Caralis and Panormus grew to size 9.

### AL FATAMID CALIPHATE AL QAIRA

*Muhtadi Fatb ibn Abdul, Fatamid Caliph of Egypt*

**DIPLOMACY** Lybia (nt)

Work on a road link between Ad'diffah to Lybia was completed and the region itself brought into the Egyptian fold. To the south, the Pagans of Dongala embraced the Islamic faith. Other than that, and the raising of more troops and the building of more ships things remained pretty quiet.

## WEST AFRICA

---

### THE KINGDOM OF GHANA

*Kwazi II, Lord of Kumbi-Saleh*

**DIPLOMACY**

Kwazi raised a whole raft-load of troops (how many is a raft-load is anyone's guess).

### THE KINGDOM OF TOGO

*Ohene, King of Togo and Akan*

**DIPLOMACY**

Ohene decided to pound upon the Kanem-Bornu yet again! Dispatching General Ayo at the head of over 37,000 troops, the Togo plowed yet again into the hard-bitten defenders (all 20,000 of them) under Prince M'tesa in Ikego and this time the attackers efforts were crowned with success! M'tesa and his troops were ground down after a tough fight and destroyed. Leaving garrisons in Ikego and Keluka, Ayo drove on into Kano which was also occupied (along with the un-walled city of N'jamena). Ayo troops finally marched into Kanem-Bornu itself and ran headlong into over 13,000 cavalry under King Susiseko himself. Here the tables were turned and Ayo's army was ridden down and utterly destroyed, the general himself being lanced during the rout. Not willing to risk his horses in the fetid southern regions, Susiseko let the few survivors (less than 3,000) flee.

### THE KINGDOM OF KANEM-BORNU

*Susiseko V, King of Kanem and Bornu*

**DIPLOMACY** Kreda (a), Salamat (f), N'jimi (fa)

See above for all the carnage!

## SOUTH AFRICA

---

### THE KINGDOM OF NYASA

*Shaka, Chief of the Nyasa*

**DIPLOMACY** Masai (a)

A new port on Lake Nyasa, Maniamba, was built in Malawai.

### THE KINGDOM OF ROZWI

*Shaka III, King of Rozwi, Lord of Zimbabwe*

**DIPLOMACY** None

Activities in the far west continued as a new city, Huambo, was built in Etosha; the region itself was colonized to a (2/3)

and a road was built between there and Lunda. Munyika died in 1242 and was succeeded by his heir, Shaka, after a brief regency. What? You didn't now who Munyika was? Well that's not surprising as I forgot to put his name in the ruler line when his predecessor croaked some time back...the ref's been missing his medication.

### THE KINGDOM OF VAAL

*Shaka II, King of Vaal and Mapungubwe*

**DIPLOMACY** Sakalava (c), Mahabo (c)

Built troops, shuffled leaqders around and did diplomacy on a big island far, far away.

## NORTH AMERICA

**CAV COUNT: 75**

---

**Pox Reminder: You CAN repopulate regions at the reduced 10nfp/10gps per level. The reduced rate ONLY applies to repopulating old levels. New levels (for those regions hit by pox before they had reached their full colonization potential have to be colonized at the regular rate. Cities destroyed by the pox must be rebuilt as new cities.**

**Regions totally depopulated AND with no garrisons have been either removed from your stat sheets (or if there's a surviving city in them, marked as UN; so the Incan player is very lucky he garrisoned his Central American holdings). Roads entering or running through such regions are destroyed UNLESS they enter an existing city within the region. Roads in regions isolated by pox-depopulated regions are destroyed as well.**

**Yes, I know you all hate me...**

### THE TLINGIT PEOPLE

*Ka-Seen, Chief of the Tlingit, Lord of the Far North.*

**DIPLOMACY** None

Smallpox swept into the Tlingit homeland, running its deadly course.

### CALIFORNIA

*Sea Coyote, Ruler of California*

**DIPLOMACY** None

Pomo was repopulated to a (1/9) and buckets of gold were poured into public works as well.

### THE ANASAZI NATION

*Desert Wind, Chief of the Anasazi, Lord of the Chaco*

**DIPLOMACY** None effect

Apache and Pisones were cut loose, to try to make up for the thin government. In other events, colonists continued to resettle Anasazi, and also moved into Tiwa, Hohokam, and Chiracaua [repopulated to (3/4), (2/4), (2/5), and (1/3) respectively]. Princess Alyana, the Chief's aunt, died at the end of 1244, leaving Desert Wind as the sole surviving member of his clan to survive the death.

### THE MISSISSIPPIAN EMPIRE

*Patamon II, the Great Beaver of the Snake*

**DIPLOMACY** None

Michigamea and Sangamon were re-colonized to their old levels of (4/4) and (2/6) respectively.

## THE NATCHEZ CONFEDERACY

*Red Bird, Great Sun of the Natchez*

**DIPLOMACY** None

Recovery on the gulf continued as well, with Karankawa, Tonkawa, and Wichita being repopulated to their old levels.

## THE YAMASEE PEOPLE

*Gliding Falcon, Chief of the Yamasee*

**DIPLOMACY** None

Yamasee continued to be resettled, this time to a (2/6).

## MESOAMERICA

---

### THE TOLTEC HEGEMONY OF CHICHEN ITZA

*Quatayilla II, Grand Hegemon of the Maya*

**DIPLOMACY** None

Like just about everyone else, the Mayans continued to dig themselves out. Colonizing Nahuatal, Otomi and Popoluca to their pre-pox levels.

## SOUTH AMERICA

---

### THE MIGHTY INCAN EMPIRE

*Ataxalpa, Emperor of the Incas*

**DIPLOMACY** None

Using some scavenged resources and manpower, Achi, in Pisac was rebuilt. Elsewhere, the pox swept through the last of the Incan lands, obliterating the mountain people of the southeast and scything through the cities of the southwest with lethal effect.

### THE KINGDOM OF KARANGA [DEAD, DO YOU HEAR! DEAD, DEAD, DEAD!]

*Amaru VI, Lord of the South*

**DIPLOMACY** None

**UTTERLY AND COMPLETELY OBLITERATED  
BY THEW POX BY THE END OF 1245.**

Well okay that and the fact that the ref was tired of running the place by remote. The cities are destroyed and the pre-pox population gp/rv levels will be put in small type in the regions so that any future colonizers know the colony maximums.

### THE KINGDOM OF SHOKLENG
